

## **ALIMENTIAMO LA MEMORIA**

We are pleased to invite you to an experiential itinerary entitled, "Alimentiamo la memoria" conceived by Pol.i.s Foundation in collaboration with I.S. V. Veneto of Naples. We have designed three tourist itineraries in Campania with the intention of promoting the heritage of property confiscated from the Camorra

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## Itinerary 1 Memory and the city of Naples

Stop 01 - The itinerary dedicated to the victims of the Camorra starts here: from the EAV station of Montesanto, entitled to Petru Birladenau, killed during a shooting between clans of Camorra in 2009. From the station, walk towards P.zza Carità and reach Via Toledo – Spanish Quarters, created in the 16th century to house Spanish soldiers. Now they became an attraction not to be missed



Stop 02 -At the end of Via Toledo, crossing Piazza del Plebiscito and walking throug Via C. Console, you reach the "Stele della memoria" crafted by the architect A. De Baggis. It symbolizes the civil commitment not to forget the innocent victims of Mafia.

Stop 03 -At a walking distance you reach another fundamental stop: "La Bottega dei sapori e dei saperi della legalità" established by Fondazione Polis aimed to promote agrifood products made on confiscated land.

Stop 04 - In Piazza del Municipio a light meal at "La Buvette di Eva", a project for the social inclusion of women in situations of difficulty, located in the Foyer of Mercadante Theatre since 2022. Here you can taste savory pies and sweets in the location it is also possible to purchase jams, spreads and taralli (savory rounded biscuits). La Buvette is part of the Cooperativa Eva, located in Casal di Principe, which enhances the agri-food produced in the confiscated lands taken from the Camorra.

## Itinerary 2

Crossing the lands of Don Diana


Stop 01 -This itinerary is dedicated to Don Diana, the anti-Camorra priest, murdered in his Church in Casal di Principe because of his fight for legality, freedom, and justice being uncomfortable for organized crime. The journey through the lands of Don Diana begins by visiting "Casa di Don Diana" (Don Diana's House), a former shelter for teenagers, confiscated in 2004 from Egidio Coppola. It is possible to book educational workshops.

Stop 02 - The exploration continues to the laboratories of the "CEDA - Centro di Educazione e Documentazione Ambientale" (Center for Environmental Education and Documentation), created by the AGRINASCE consortium. This property was confiscated from F. Schiavone and named to Pio La Torre. On the same site is present a renewable energy biogas production facility.



Stop 03 - Lunch will be served in "NCO Nuova cucina organizzata" (NCO New Organized Kitchen) with dishes prepared with agri-food products coming from confiscated land.

Stop 04 - Finally, the itinerary ends visiting the social cooperative "LE TERRE DI DON PEPPE DIANA", part of the "Libera Terra" (Free Land) project of "Libera". An agricultural estate confiscated from Michele Zaza in 1994. Here, it is possible to purchase and/or taste the award-winning mozzarella made with excellent local milk.



Stop 01 - "The courage to be free" itinerary is dedicated to Giancarlo Siani, a journalist killed by Camorra, symbol of the freedom of thought, against those who try to silence the truth. Words and ideas are powerful, and the Mafia worried about them, as history taught us. This itinerary through the Vesuvian lands begins in Ercolano, in the editorial office of "Radiosiani", managed by the Giancarlo Siani Cooperative in a property confiscated from the clan.

Stop 02 - Visit to "Villa Bruno" in San Giorgio a Cremano, where the convertible Mehari car of the journalist is exposed, as symbol of freedom, completely opened, without any protection or shields to defend itself: freedom has no fear.

Stop 03 - Lunch will be served at "Masseria Aiello" in San Sebastiano al Vesuvio, where it is possible to taste Unipam bread, a consortium of anti-racket bakers.

Stop 04 - The Vesuvian towns tour ends in the afternoon with a visit to the Medicean Castle of Ottaviano, a majestic historical structure built in the Lombard age, owned by Raffaele Cutolo, head of Nuova Camorra Organizzata (NCO), that has been confiscated and now subject to architectural constraints.
